

Littering

No To Pyrotechnics



The football club in conjunction with the EFL, are working with FA, Premiership & the Conference to launch a new campaign highlighting the dangers of pyrotechnics, whether they be fireworks, smoke bombs or flares.

As part of the campaign the club has put up a number of posters around the Globe Arena as displayed above. These posters detail the dangers of using pyrotechnics at football grounds, & the potential harm they cause to both users & fellow supporters.—such as coughing, choking or asthma attacks

leading to somebody young or old requiring the services of the A&E.

One poster highlights the extreme temperature a flare can reach, 1600°C, more than enough to burn plastic seating or melt metal; let alone injury to a person, whether that it a spectator or a steward defusing the item.

It has to be remembered the use any pyrotechnics in or around the ground is strictly prohibited, & could ultimately result in the club incurring fines from the FA & the EFL, along with increased costs in policing the ground. Please Party Without Pyro!
